

# Health and Wellbeing Survey

A fantastic FREE opportunity to gain valuable data to support the personal development and health and wellbeing of your pupils.

Nottingham City Council's Public Health Team are once again inviting schools to complete the citywide Health and Wellbeing survey between September and mid-November 2026. The results can be used to **support schools' health and wellbeing provision in the academic year 2026/27.**

The Schools Health Education Unit (SHEU) have been commissioned to undertake this survey for Nottingham City children, targeted at Year 6 pupils in primary and Year 10 in secondary schools (other year groups are available). Schools receive a detailed report outlining their pupils' data with comparisons to city wide results.

The survey supports schools to evidence pupil voice and plan responsive, relevant PSHE and personal development.

The survey can be completed electronically or on paper copies and should only take an hour to complete.
